

Stage 1 – Rifle & Pistol

COURSE DESIGNER: Jonathan Slayton

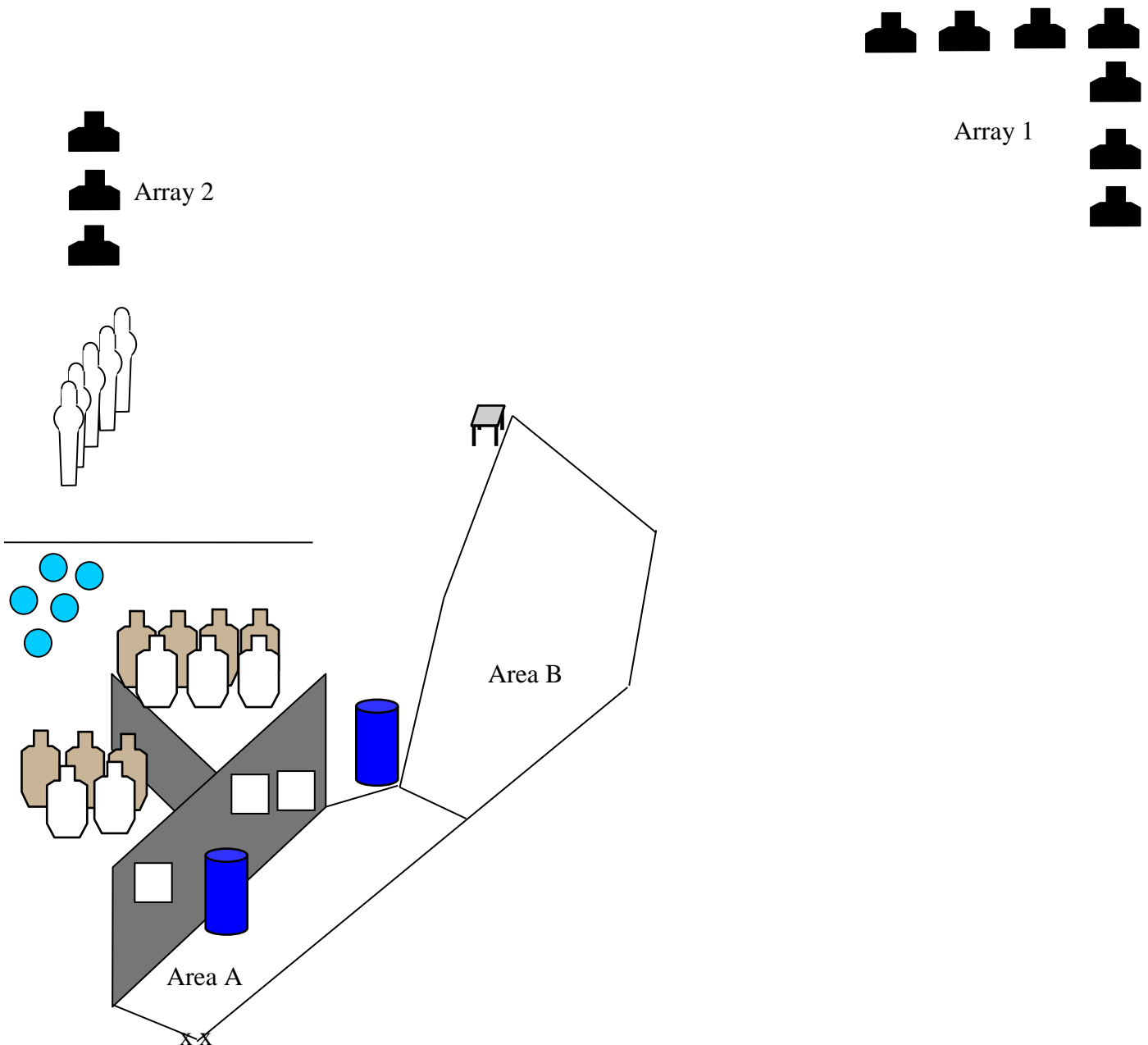
START POSITION: Facing downrange, heels on X's, loaded handgun in holster, (optional) rifle loaded low ready, and tourniquet held in supplied carrier in any location on the shooter's person.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal engage targets from within shooting areas. Shooter may use any combination of firearms to safely negotiate the stage. Array 2 must be engaged with the uninjured hand with the pistol after tourniquet is applied after the stage is completed. **Falling steel may not be engaged with a rifle. Array 1 may only be engaged with the rifle from Area A or with the pistol from Area A or B. Grounded weapons must be on safe or empty and pointed in safe direction. 90 second max time.**

SCORING: Time-plus, 34 rounds, 100 points

TARGETS: 10 C-Zones, 7 IPSC, 5 Pistol Plates, 8 Pepper Poppers



Scenario

You respond to a Robbery Alarm at a bank and take a covered position outside. Dispatch calls the bank who advised the alarm is false, and the manager steps outside to meet you. The manager takes a few nervous steps outside then runs away screaming, "They're shooting us!" as you hear gunfire and screaming from inside the bank.
